



ONS/ONCC Chemotherapy Biotherapy Certificate Renewal Course

Frequently Asked Questions

When will the chemotherapy renewal course become available?

Registration for the ONS/ONCC Chemotherapy Biotherapy Certificate Renewal Course is now open.

Who can take the renewal course?

If you have earned your provider card and certificate of added qualification in 2014, you will be eligible to take the ONS/ONCC Chemotherapy/Biotherapy Certificate Renewal Course.

If you have completed the live 2-day ONS Chemotherapy Biotherapy course or Chemotherapy Renewal in 2012 or 2013 you will need to complete the ONS/ONCC Chemotherapy Biotherapy Certificate Course. The newly-launching renewal course is designed specifically for nurses who have taken the online certificate course that launched in 2014, and is not valid for nurses who have taken the live 2-day course and have been renewing that card online ever since.

How much does the course cost?

The cost is \$80 for members, and \$103 for nonmembers.

What is the group rate if I purchase more than 5 registrations?

ONS offers discounted pricing for institutions and employers. The institutional pricing options reflect a per-person cost.

6–10 Registrants (Save 20%):	\$64
11–20 Registrants (Save 25%):	\$60
21–49 Registrants (Save 30%):	\$56
50–99 Registrants (Save 35%):	\$52
100+ Registrants (Save 40%):	\$48

Do institutions need to register all attendees at once to get the discount?

No, you do not need to enroll everyone right away to receive the discount, but you will need to order the number you need at the time of purchase.

How many vouchers should I purchase?

To qualify for the institutional pricing discounts listed in the table above, consider purchasing the quantity you expect to use over a 12-month period in advance. For example, if you expect to have 15 individuals who will take the course within the next year, you should purchase 15 vouchers to receive the respective discount levels. ONS vouchers will be processed within five to seven business days upon receipt of payment from an institution. Email institutions@ons.org for questions on vouchers.

How will staff redeem the vouchers?

The individual purchasing the course vouchers distributes them to staff. Vouchers will be used to make payment at the time of registration.

Note. Course vouchers will carry an expiration date of 12 months from the date of purchase (or from September 25 if vouchers were purchased in advance).

How many contact hours of CNE will be offered?

The course is worth 5.3 contact hours of CNE.

What if I want to cancel my registration?

If you wish to cancel your online course registration, you must notify ONS by sending your request via email to help@ons.org before accessing the course. ONS will provide you a monetary refund equal to the cost of the course registration minus 30% cancellation fee.

Are there specific start and end dates like the certificate course?

The ONS/ONCC Chemotherapy Biotherapy Certificate Renewal Course is an on-demand course and does not have a maximum enrollment (unlike the initial certificate course).

On-demand, what does that mean?

This means the nurse receives instructions regarding how to access the course immediately at time of registration. The nurse will then have full access to the course content for 6 months.

Does that mean nurses must wait 6 months to receive their certificates and provider card?

Great news! Nurses will be able to print cards and certificates when they complete all requirements. There will no longer be a waiting period for the release of these items.
