Target Audience	<p>Any nurse or other healthcare professional who is administering chemotherapy/biotherapy or plans to administer chemotherapy/biotherapy.</p> <p>This is a course intended to provide the fundamentals of administration regardless of the volume and frequency of chemotherapy and biotherapy administered.</p>	<p>This course is intended for nurses who have knowledge of cancer basics and are in a position to regularly administer chemotherapy and biotherapy. It builds on a foundation of cancer knowledge and experience, with the learner earning a certificate of added qualification upon successful completion.</p> <p>It is not an introductory program.</p>
Course Goal	This course presents content to meet the essential ONS standard to safely provide care for individuals receiving chemotherapy and biotherapy.	To best prepare and reinforce critical information for safe administration and use evidence to manage acute side effects and adverse events related to chemotherapy and biotherapy administration.
Documentation provided after successful completion	CNE certificate illustrating contact hours of CNE earned. ONS provider card.	Certificate of Added Qualification. CNE certificate illustrating contact hours of CNE earned. ONS provider card.
Course Format	Online course, offered on-demand and at your own pace. Learners will have 6 months to complete the course. The content is interactive with quizzes, required post-test and required evaluation. The course is not facilitated and there are no registration limits. The course will offer an e-book version of the ONS Chemotherapy Biotherapy Guidelines.	Online course, facilitated by nurses with expertise in administration, safe handling, and education of chemotherapy and biotherapy. The content is interactive with quizzes, required discussions, required post-test, and optional evaluation. Because the course is facilitated there are scheduled start and end dates and some registration limits. ONS has sufficient facilitators on board for 2016 to minimize any wait time for course entry. The course will offer an e-book version of the ONS Chemotherapy Biotherapy Guidelines.
